

AFRINIC at Glance


- **33 full time staff** (11 join in 2012)
- **2,935,293 /32** IPv4 allocated in 2012
- Still **have 4.14** (including ERX space)
- **98 New members** in 2012 making our total membership **to 1,248**
- **15 training** in 2012 (in 14 countries)
- **66 new IPv6** prefixes allocated (100%+ growth in IPv6 Allocations)
- **5 New Policies** under discussion



- **RPKI:** Continue working on our RPKI service.
- **DNSsec:** Sign all our zone and also now provide the service to our members
- **DNS Anycast** service for our infrastructure and ccTLDs: More than 10 ccTLDs using the service now (few still waiting for update at IANA level)
- **e-voting** platform deployment and Integration to MyAFRINIC
- Transitioning to a full **Virtualized** Infrastructure
